

Northeast Mississippi Community College Annual High School Art Competition

Qualifications: The competition is open to all high school students attending any high school in Alcorn, Prentiss, Tippah, Tishomingo, or Union counties.

Entries must be original and completed during the current school year and must represent the individual effort of the entrant.

Type of Entry: Paintings in all media, drawing, designs, photography/computer art/printmaking, and 3-D design/ceramics.

Rules of entry: Each High School will be limited to a total of 15 (fifteen) 2-D pieces and 3 (three) 3-D pieces.

1. Work must be original (Not a copy from any other artists' work).
2. Work must have the following information attached to the lower left-hand corner of the back of the work.

(Please use labels provided.)

3. Paintings must be suitably presented. Custom framing or strip framing is acceptable as well as painted edges. All paintings must have proper hardware attached to the back for hanging. Drawings and designs must be suitably matted and covered with clear plastic or acetate, must have cardboard backing, and string inserted in back for hanging.

Works not properly matted or framed will not be hung!
